

## Positive Behavior Intervention and Support (PBIS)

### WHY PBIS?

PBIS - Replaces undesired behaviors with a new behavior or skill

PBIS - Alters environments, teaches appropriate skills and rewards appropriate behavior.

### PBIS at Williamston Primary School

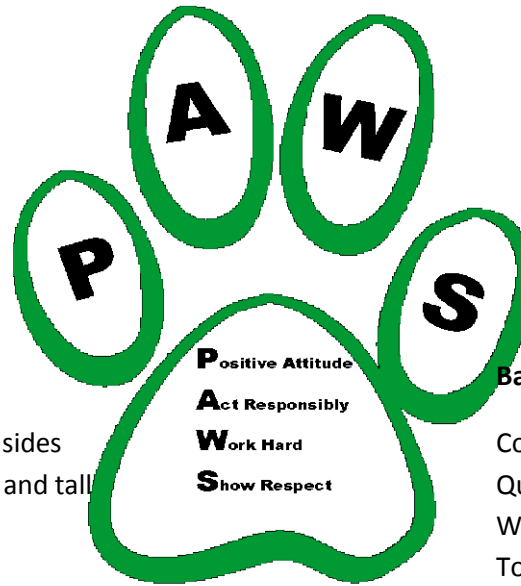
#### Expectations: PAWS

P- Positive behavior

A – Act responsibly

W – Work hard

S – Show respect



#### Hallways

With our hands by our sides

#### WPS Rewards Incentives

Individual – students who displayed expected behavior 80% of the time for the six week grading period will be eligible to participate in the school wide reward party/activity.

Class – classes that have 80% of the students displaying expected behavior for the six week grading period will be eligible for a class reward.

Student of the Month – 1 student is chosen per class for this reward which is displayed in the school.
